ORDINANCE NO. 1526

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE WATER RATES FOR THE VILLAGE OF GLANDORF, OHIO

Whereas, the Council of the Village of GLANDORF, Ohio, met at a duly called and authorized meeting of the Council, such meeting being duly called pursuant to the rules of Council, with notice received by all Council members; and

Whereas, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare; and

Whereas, the Council of the Village of GLANDORF, Ohio takes immediate action to increase the water rates to be henceforth charged to users of the water system of the Village of Glandorf, Ohio.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GLANDORF, OHIO, BY AT LEAST TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

SECTION I. The rate to be charged to the users of the Village of Glandorf water system shall be increased to \$6.86 from \$6.53 per 1000 gallons of water effective on the May 1, 2025 bill.

SECTION II. That all other ordinances, resolutions, or orders, or sections, subsections or parts thereof which may be in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION III. That, in the event any portion of this Ordinance shall be found by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability thereof, shall not affect the remaining provisions of the Ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION IV. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, peace and general welfare of the Village of Glandorf and the inhabitants thereof so that users of the water and sewage systems of the Village of Glandorf will be billed correctly and as such this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and virtue upon passage with the terms thereof.
