ORDINANCE NO. 1501

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING REGULATIONS FOR THE OPERATION OF TROLLEY BAR BIKES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF GLANDORF, OHIO

WHEREAS, Council desires to and believes it is in the best interest of the residents to regulate the operation of Trolley Bar Bikes within the Village limits of Glandorf, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to require an inspection and approval of Trolley Bar Bikes before use within the Village.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF GLANDORF, PUTNAM COUNTY, OHIO, TWO-THIRDS (2/3) OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING, THAT:

Section I: DEFINITIONS:

- (a) Low Speed Vehicle has the same meaning as set forth in Ohio Revised Code 4501.01 (WW), except a Low-Speed Vehicle, as defined in this Section may have more than four (4) wheels.
- (b) Motor Vehicle has the same meaning as set forth in Ohio Revised code 4501.01 (B).
- (c) Trolley Bar Bike is a Low-Speed Motor Vehicle as that term is defined under Ohio Revised Code 4501.01 (WW), and as modified by Section 1 (a) above.

Section II: INSPECTION:

- (a) No person shall operate a Trolley Bar Bike on the streets within the Village of Glandorf, Ohio, unless the Trolley Bar Bike has been inspected and approved by the Chief of Police or his/her designee for compliance with the State of Ohio's statutory requirements that are applicable to Motor Vehicles. Appointments for inspections can be scheduled through the Glandorf Police Department.
- (b) If the Chief of Police or his/her designee determines that the Trolley Bar Bike complies with the minimum State of Ohio statutory requirements applicable to Motor Vehicles, a Certificate of Compliance shall be issued.

Section III: OPERATION

- (a) While operating a Trolley Bar Bike on the streets within the Village, all owners and operators shall comply with any and all laws pertaining to Motor Vehicles including, without limitation, safety requirements and insurance requirements.
- (b) While a Trolley Bar Bike is being operated on the streets of the Village, it shall at all times comply with the requirements it was approved under to obtain the Certificate of Compliance.

- (c) The operator or driver of the Trolley Bar Bike must have a valid driver's license.
- (d) The operator or driver must maintain the Trolley Bar Bike within two (2) feet of the right-side curb, giving right of way to passing passenger vehicles.
- (e) Except as otherwise stated in this Ordinance, no Trolley Bar Bike shall be operated upon any street in the Village where the posted speed limit is greater than 35 miles per hour.
- (f) No Trolley Bar Bike passenger shall be under the age of eighteen (18) to ride or under the age of twenty-one (21) to consume alcohol.
- (g) Trolley Bar Bike accessories shall not consist of glass bottles, glasses or other breakable items.
- (h) Tolley Bar Bikes shall consist of and include safety requirement lighting and shall not have any bright flashing entertainment lighting.
- (i) No Trolley Bar Bike shall be operated on any sidewalk, except to cross the sidewalk, as may be necessary from time to time.

Section IV: PENALTY

Whoever violates this Ordinance is guilty of a minor misdemeanor on a first offense; on a second offense within one (1) year after the first offense, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree; for each subsequent offense beyond two (2) offenses within one (1) year, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree.

Section V. This Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
