ORDINANCE NO. 1497

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE WATER RATES FOR THE VILLAGE OF GLANDORF, OHIO

WHEREAS, it having come before Council of the Village of Glandorf, Ohio, that the necessity exists to take immediate action to establish rates to be henceforth charged to users of the water system of the Village of Glandorf, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GLANDORF, STATE OF OHIO, UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THE MEMBERS THERETO CONCURRING:

SECTION I. The rate to be, as of April 1, 2020, charged to the users of the Village of Glandorf water system shall be as follows:

A. Water Rate: For inside the Village the rate shall be \$10.75 monthly base rate plus \$6.12 per 1000 gallons of water used. In addition, filling of a swimming pool inside the Village shall be at a fee of \$75.00. The yard meter rate shall be \$11.08 per 1000 gallons of water used. For outside the Village, the rate shall be \$12.86 per 1000 gallons of water used. Filling of a swimming pool outside the Village shall be the rate of \$12.86 per 1000 gallons of water used plus a fee of \$75.00.

SECTION II. Said charges shall be billed to the users of said system on a monthly basis and said charges shall be paid by the users of said system by the last business day of the month, otherwise, there shall be a penalty amounting to ten percent (10%) of the subject bill, and said penalty shall be charged upon subsequent billings until the same shall be paid in full. All such billings and penalty charges shall be subject to collection by means of certification upon the users tax duplicate pursuant to the provisions of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION III. That all other ordinances, resolutions, or orders, or sections, subsections or parts thereof which may be in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and hereby are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION IV. That, in the event any portion of this Ordinance shall be found by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability thereof, shall not affect the remaining provisions of the Ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION V. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, peace and general welfare of the Village of Glandorf and the inhabitants thereof so that users of the water and sewage systems of the Village of Glandorf will be billed correctly and as such this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and virtue upon passage with the terms thereof.

SECTION VI. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
